Founded in 2018 to bridge the gap in providing an immediate safe space, Feathers Futures is unique in its easy-to-access location, instant, supportive, safe haven, and ongoing support it offers women across Great Yarmouth. We aim to be a place for women to come and make friends, socialise, learn new skills and receive support.

Feathers Futures brings women into a connected community group, providing a safe, non-judgmental environment. As a result, women can have a voice and express feelings while being heard and understood.

Supported by a mix of volunteers and staff, we offer a range of expertise to help women to create a brighter future. Over the years, we have created enjoyable small groups, including drop-in sessions, counselling, domestic abuse tool kit, Feathers Friends, classes and groups, a book club and art sessions.

Through our small groups and varied tailored programmes, Feathers Futures are proud to have helped create a better future for hundreds of women each year.



How your money will help



How your fundraising will make a real difference

- £5 pays for someone's bus fare to attend a session who wouldn't be able to otherwise
- £10 pays for the refreshments for the Own My Life 12-week course
- £15 pays for an Own My Life journal and resources for one person to attend the course
- £25 covers all our volunteer counsellors' expenses for one week providing counselling to up to 25 women each week
- £50 covers two volunteers' induction training
- £120 pays for all the resources needed to deliver one course of It's All About Me! helping eight women rebuild their confidence and self-esteem
- £200 pays for all the resources needed to deliver one course of The Domestic Abuse Recovery Toolkit 12-week course

Your funds will provide equipment, volunteer coordination and training required to deliver our tailored services for women—directly helping women by enabling Feathers Futures to continue supporting and creating a brighter for many women each year.


Feathers Futures restoring and growing confidence How your donation will make a difference



Brainstorm

Think of location, time, and place.

Where will you hold your event? Will it be online or in person? Is there a venue you can use? How many people does it need to hold?

When is the best time to hold it? When will most of your supporters be free? Check that your date and time don't clash with any other events. Should it be tied to a specific calendar date?

Please keep it safe and legal.

Your event must be safe and legal for all those involved. Research any information you need clarification on, or speak with Feathers Futures.





Shout about it

How will you tell people about your event? Think emails, social media, media, posters and word of mouth. Speak with friends, family and work colleagues, tell them about your ideas, get them involved.

Please contact the team at Feathers Futures, and we can provide you with poster templates and other fundraising tools to help you tell everyone about your plans. ρ

The local media love to share good news stories. Could you tell local media the details of your event - think about papers, radio and online outlets.

Make sure you also speak with them afterwards and communicate your successes.



Social Media

Create eye-catching posts and make sure you include all the information, such as date, time, and of course, information about Feathers Futures and how all donations will make a difference. Maximise your fundraising



How can you give your efforts a boost? Could you maximise the impact?

At your event, you have a captive audience. How can you maximise fundraising impact? Could you add a raffle? Maybe speak with local businesses and see if they want to donate prizes?

You can sell tickets - not only will this help your target, but it also ensures that people attend.

Match funding - would your workplace match fund donations?

Add links or QR codes to Feathers Futures donation page or a site like Justgiving. It is easier to get people to donate at the moment rather than relying on filling out forms and losing the urgency.

Gift Aid is a scheme which allows charities like Feathers Futures to claim from HMRC the basic rate of tax their donors have paid. Gift Aid increases the value of donations by 25%, so even more money comes to Feathers Futures. The best bit is that it doesn't cost you at all, and you have to do is ask those donating to tick to confirm that they qualify.

This means that if you raise £100 and your sponsors tick the Gift Aid box, it becomes £125.

<u>JustGiving</u> and <u>go fund me</u> enable you to set up a fundraising page to collect sponsorship from family and friends and is fast and easy to set up and use.
